BCON's Bridge Education Pathway Program (BEPP) is progressing as planned:

- <u>18</u> newcomers are currently following the 27-hour ACBL course (#102) on "*Bidding*" which is presented by **Viola Heywood**.
- <u>12</u> intermediate players are currently following the 24-hour ACBL course (#203) on "*Commonly Used Conventions*" which is presented by Chandi Jayawardena.
- Lorna Johnson & Kathy Morrison commenced their "Easybridge" 2018 program at BCON, which had between <u>12</u> to 6 newcomers attending the four free sessions.
- Chandi Jayawardena will commence the 24-hour ACBL course (#301) on "More Commonly Used Conventions" in July.
- Muriel Tremblay will commence the 24-hour ACBL course (#201) on "Play of the Hand" in August.
